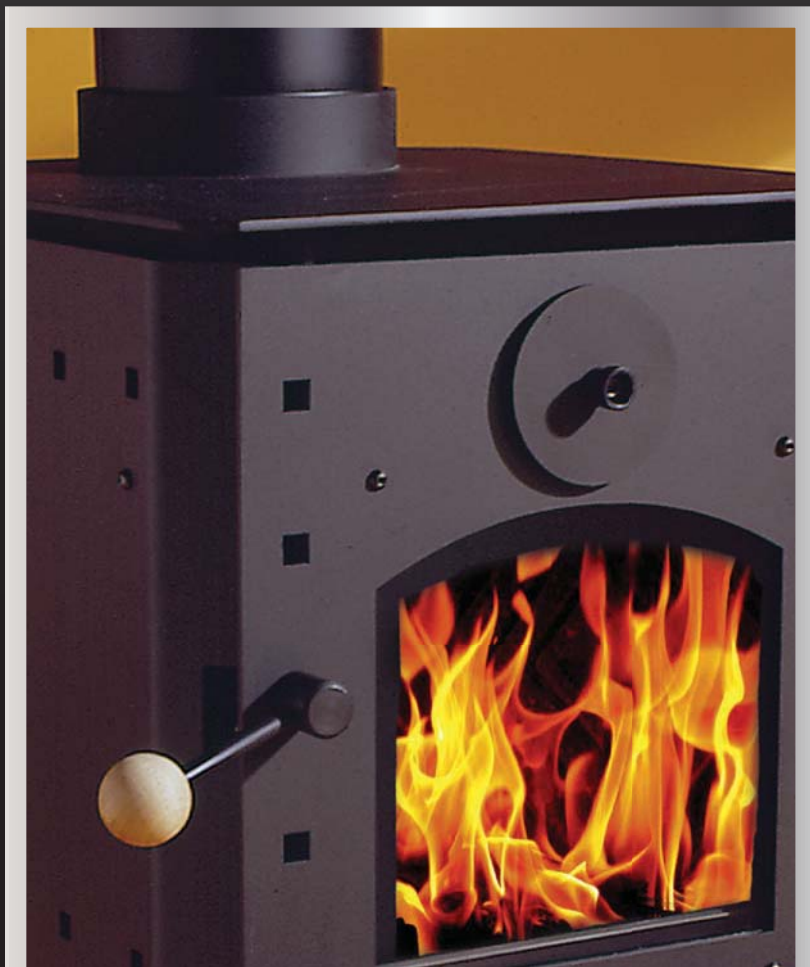

STUDIO AND OH-AH FIRES

The STUDIO is the perfect compliment to both contemporary and traditional interiors and is built right here in New Zealand for our unique conditions. Designed by Peter Haythornthwaite, its simplicity of shape expresses the logic of its design and inbuilt technology.

ENVIRONMENTALLY FRIENDLY

The STUDIO meets the required New Zealand standards for emission control. We have our own test facilities and invest heavily into research and development because we believe in doing the right thing for the environment, and our customers.

SAFETY FEATURES

The STUDIO is mainly a convectional stove – it has an inner and outer skin whereby air from the room flows between the surfaces, thus becoming hot and efficiently heating the room. This Double Skin feature ensures the outer skin stays relatively cooler than a full radiation stove (ie. Pot belly), and is therefore a safer option. The Studio Oven is ideal for entertainment at home or cooking for holiday homes and farm cottages. Food can be kept warm and electricity saved.

REDUCE HEATING COSTS

The wood fire is still the most affordable form of home heating. Warmington's fires are designed to heat large spaces with a maximum heat output of approx.14 kw when using dry, seasoned wood. The Studio fires can be used for cooking, heating and a hot water booster with the wetback option.
